THE LIBRARY

The Library of History of Padua University holds one of the most complete history collections in Italy, constantly updating and growing.

The Library's holding includes about 95.000 books, 300 current subscription to periodicals, 300 periodicals that are out of print or no longer subscribed to, microfilms, CD-ROM and ancient books.

The main disciplinary areas are: **Medieval, Modern and Contemporary History, Local History, History of Christianity and Ancient Christian literature, Paleography, Archival Studies, Librarianship.**

The library buys all the handbooks and texts recommended for all history courses.

The largest part of the collection is available on an **open shelf**, and the books are shelved according to a topic classification scheme.

A part of the collection is placed in external stores (Deposito di Legnaro and Deposito di Palazzo Beldomandi): you can book the items through GalileoDiscovery or ask the front desk and they will be available to you in a couple of days.

The Library is open to everybody.

There are **104 seats in 6 reading rooms**; Room Legnaro is reserved to University of Padua scholars and professors.

SEARCH TOOL

GALILEO DISCOVERY

GalileoDiscovery is a discovery service for searching books, articles, journals and many other resources, both print and electronic.

With GalileoDiscovery you can search in the collections of the libraries that cooperate in the Padua Library System.

By logging in it is possible to use some personalized services, such as reserving a book on loan, renewing loans, and requesting volumes from external stores.

Institutional users can log in with SSO credentials, guest users with social login (Google, Facebook or Twitter credentials).

BORROWING BOOKS

The service can be used by all university users and guest users possessing a library system Card (cost 1 Euro).

The University Library lends different numbers of books to different categories of readers.

- *Professors, Scholars, post lauream, staff:* **20 books for 60 days;**
- *University of Padova students:* **15 books for 30 days;**
- *Guest users:* **5 books for 30 days.**

Institutional users can ask for up to **5 renewals**, *guest users* up to **2 renewals** (if the items are not booked by other users).

INTRA-UNIVERSITY LENDING

The intra-university lending service allows authorized users (professors, scholars, post-lauream and students with disabilities) to obtain through their reference library books held in other libraries of the University of Padova Library System.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Via the InterLibrary Loan Service, you can ask for books that are not in Padua libraries by filling out the online request form.

DOCUMENT DELIVERY

Via the Document Delivery Service, the University of Padua Libraries supply users with copies of documents, such as journal articles, book chapters, etc, not available in any of their collections. All you have to do is to contact your library. It is also possible to request documents located in the Nuovo Archivio di Legnaro.
